


LAW ON TEACHER TRAINING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

CASE STUDY
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Teacher training and professional development issues dealt with by the courts:

- period of professional development falls outside the limits of employment record;
- violations of educational and professional requirements;



Teacher training and professional development issues dealt with by the courts:


- employment positions lower than the qualification acquired;
- refusal to undertake professional development courses.



The RF Law on Education

Under Art. 46 of the RF Law on Education,

only persons educated in secondary vocational and higher professional educational institutions and meeting educational and professional requirements set forth in qualification guidelines and professional standards are entitled to being employed as teachers.



Education and Qualification Requirements

1. Lack of Teacher Training

Case № 4a-619/2013 of 7 October 2013 dealt with by the Sverdlovsk Regional Court.

Holding: a qualified technician cannot be employed to teach in any educational institution



Education and Qualification Requirements

2. Refusal to undergo professional development courses.

Case № 33-409/2014 of 29 January 2014 dealt with by Omsk Regional Court.

Holding: professional development should be organized in compliance with the teaching profile rather than the teaching category



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
